## VC International Scholarship 2015/2016

### Terms and Conditions

- The deadline for receipt of application is 30th June 2015 for courses beginning September 2015, or 15th November 2015 for courses beginning January 2016.
- Students will be notified if their application has been successful end of August 2015 for courses starting in September 2015, and end of December 2015 for courses starting in January 2016.
- Applicants must hold an unconditional or a conditional firm offer for a course at MMU. (Applicants must also have indicated that they have accepted this offer.)
- If you hold a conditional offer and apply for the VC International Scholarship, the scholarship may only be awarded once the conditions have been met.
- Applicants who intend to defer their studies must apply for a scholarship for the year they will be studying.
- Scholarships are available for new MMU students only who are classed as overseas students and are required to pay the full overseas tuition fees. Current MMU students moving from one course to another are not eligible for the scholarships.
- The scholarships will be deducted directly from tuition fees and is for one year only.
- It is the responsibility of all students to inform their Faculty programmes office directly, in writing, of any change in their circumstances at the earliest opportunity.
- A student's eligibility for the Scholarship will be automatically revoked should they fail to complete the full academic year. The student will be required to repay the full amount of Scholarship funds and MMU may take such action as is necessary to recover this amount.
- If a student wishes to exit the course at an early stage in order to gain an exit award, the finance department will pro-rata the student's entitlement to the Scholarship depending on their formal date of exit.
- Should a student leave their course due to extenuating circumstances, they will need to provide supporting evidence by email to [vc scholarships@mmu.ac.uk](mailto:vc scholarships@mmu.ac.uk). The evidence will then be considered by the University. MMU may, at its sole discretion, pro-rata eligibility for the Scholarship depending on the student's formal date of suspension/withdrawal.

- By submitting an application form, successful applicants are giving their consent to MMU to hold and process their data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. Your information including your name and photographs may be used in publicity by MMU. If you do not give your consent to your data being used in this way, you must let us know in writing at the time of the submission of the application form.
- Scholarship awards are made by the VC Scholarship Panel and all decisions are final.
- MMU reserves the right to withdraw or amend scholarships without prior notification.
- Please note that all students are required to comply with, and shall be bound by, MMU's Student Regulations and Procedures which can be viewed at <http://www.mmu.ac.uk/studenthandbook>.
- The scholarships cannot be combined with any other University bursary or awards.
