The closest public car parks to the Manchester campus are listed and marked on the city map overleaf. Some of these car parks can get busy so please allow extra time to park.



Travelling to Brooks by Public Transport

Manchester Oxford Road Train Station

You can walk to the Brooks Building in 15-20 minutes. Turn right out of Oxford Road Station and walk underneath the railway bridge. The Manchester campus is to your right. Follow the walking route from Oxford Road to the Brooks Building (see [overleaf](#)).

Manchester Piccadilly Train Station

You can catch the metro shuttle bus service 2 (green) or 1 (orange) part of the way. Get off at Whitworth Street West for bus 2 or Oxford Street for bus 1, then follow the walking route (see [overleaf](#)). The metro shuttle service runs every 8-10 minutes Monday – Saturday from 8am to 7pm. You can also walk, which takes 20-25 minutes. From the Fairfield Street station exit, follow Whitworth Street and then left on to Oxford Road. Follow the walking route from Oxford Road to the Brooks Building (see [overleaf](#)).

Manchester Victoria Train Station

Follow the signs for the free metro shuttle bus service 2 (green) or 1 (orange). Get off at Whitworth Street West for bus 2 or Oxford Street for bus 1. Continue on to Oxford Road and the Manchester campus is on your right. The metro shuttle service runs every 8-10 minutes Monday-Saturday from 8am to 7pm. Follow the walking route from Oxford Road to the Brooks Building (see [overleaf](#)).

Piccadilly Gardens Bus station

Take any of the following buses from Piccadilly Gardens direct to the Brooks building you can catch the 250, 86, 263, 256 and 291. You can also walk, which takes 15-20 minutes. Take Portland Street and then left on to Oxford Road, then follow the walking route from Oxford Road to the Brooks Building (see [overleaf](#)).

Metrolink Stop, Deansgate/Castlefield

You can walk which takes 15-20 minutes. Walk down Whitworth Street West and turn right at Oxford Road train station. The Manchester campus is on your right, then follow the walking route from Oxford Road to the Brooks Building (see [overleaf](#)).
