



International Postgraduate Scholarships 2018/2019

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility criteria

- Applicants must hold an offer for a full taught Masters course (180 credit) at Manchester Metropolitan University and begin their studies in September 2018 or January 2019
- Scholarships are available to new Manchester Metropolitan University applicants; former Manchester Met students are not eligible for the scholarship
- Applicants must be self-funding and classified as overseas for tuition fee purposes
- Applicants who achieve a First degree classification in their undergraduate studies may be eligible for the £2,000 scholarship
- Eligible applicants with a 2:1 classification undergraduate degree may be awarded a £1,500 scholarship
- International qualifications will be compared with Manchester Met's internal guidelines and all decisions made by the University's Admissions Department regarding degree classifications are final and cannot be appealed

Other conditions

- This scholarship cannot be combined with any other bursary or award
- The scholarship is for one year only
- Should a student receive another merit based award, only the one of higher value will be applied
- The scholarship will be awarded automatically upon enrolment, no application is required
- The scholarship will be deducted from tuition fees and it is for the first year of academic study only.
- The scholarship will not be carried over if a student defers entry

- If a student wishes to exit the course at an early stage in order to gain an exit award, or fails to complete the academic year, the finance department will pro-rata the student's entitlement to the scholarship depending on their date of exit
- Should a student transfer courses or change their study mode, they might be required to repay the scholarship in full
- If a student fails to pay fees as agreed, any amount awarded may be reversed and they might need to pay the full fee amount
- Should a student leave their course due to unavoidable circumstances, they will need to provide evidence by email to financialassistance@mmu.ac.uk. This evidence will then be considered by the University. Manchester Met may, at its discretion, pro-rata eligibility for the Scholarship depending on the student's date of suspension/withdrawal. Manchester Met's decision is final and cannot be subject to appeal
- Please note that all students are required to comply with, and are bound by, the University's Student Regulations and Procedures, which can be viewed at www.mmu.ac.uk/policy. If a student is removed from the course for failing to comply with the Student Regulations and Procedures they will be required to pay the scholarship back in full
